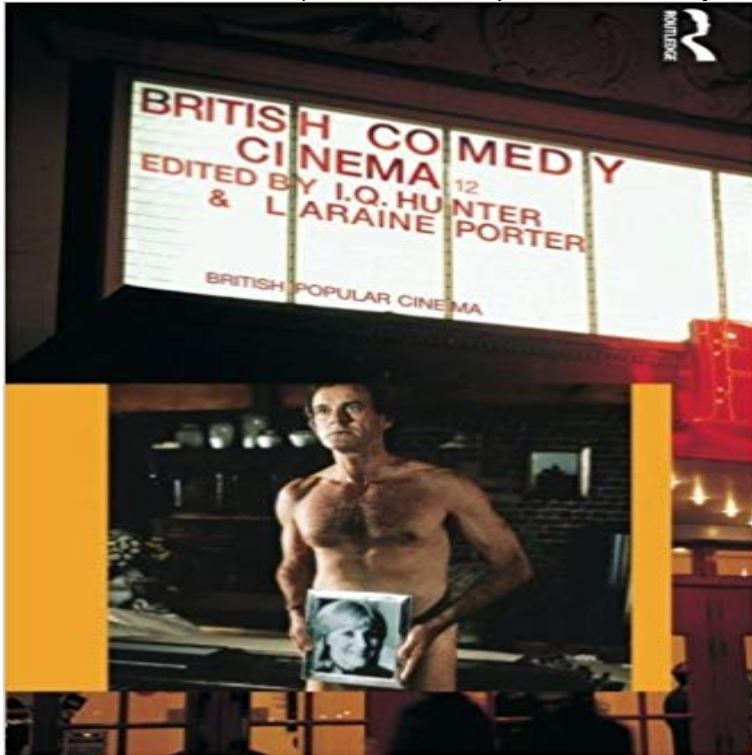


British Comedy Cinema (British Popular Cinema)
