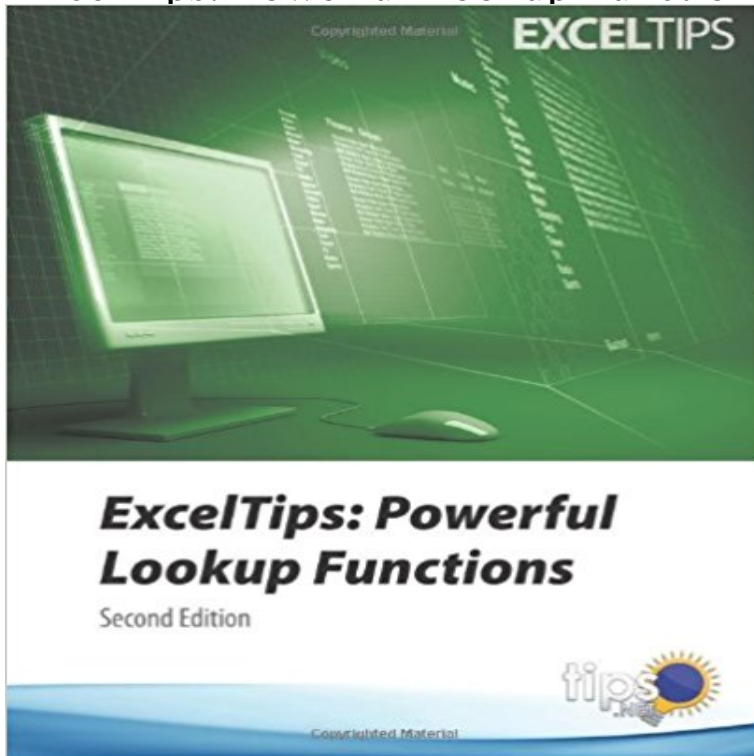


ExcelTips: Powerful Lookup Functions
