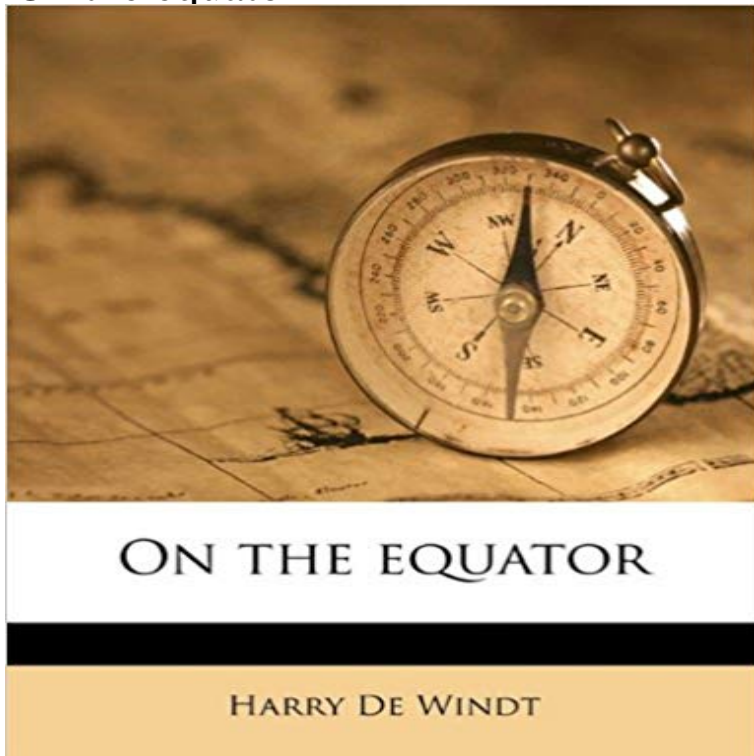


## On the equator
