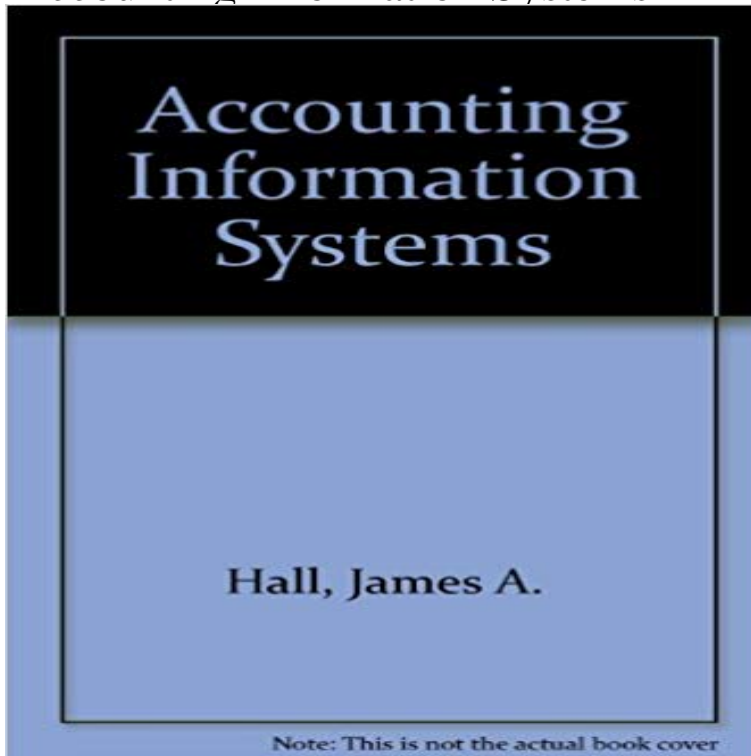


Accounting Information Systems
