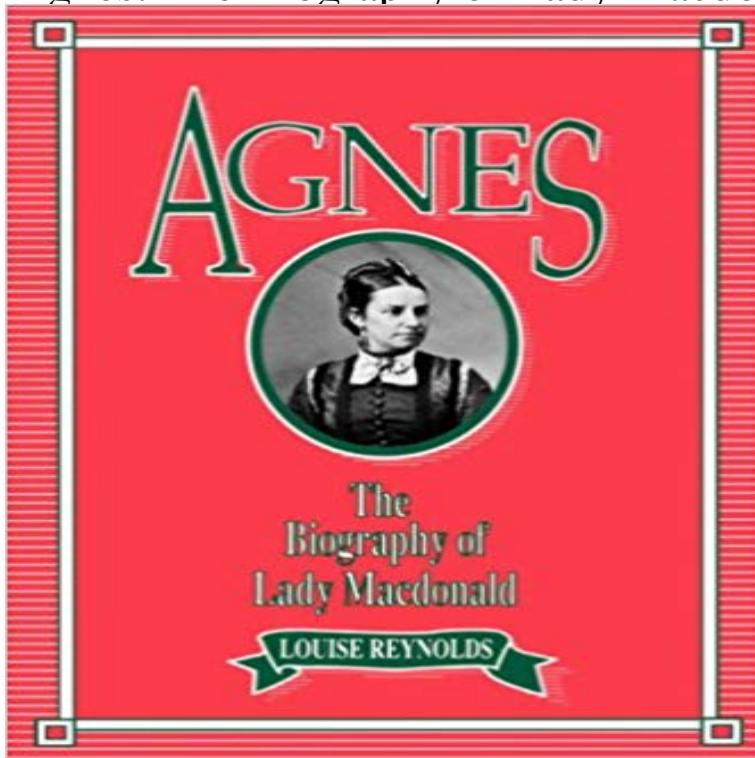


Agnes: The Biography of Lady Macdonald (Womens Experience Series)
