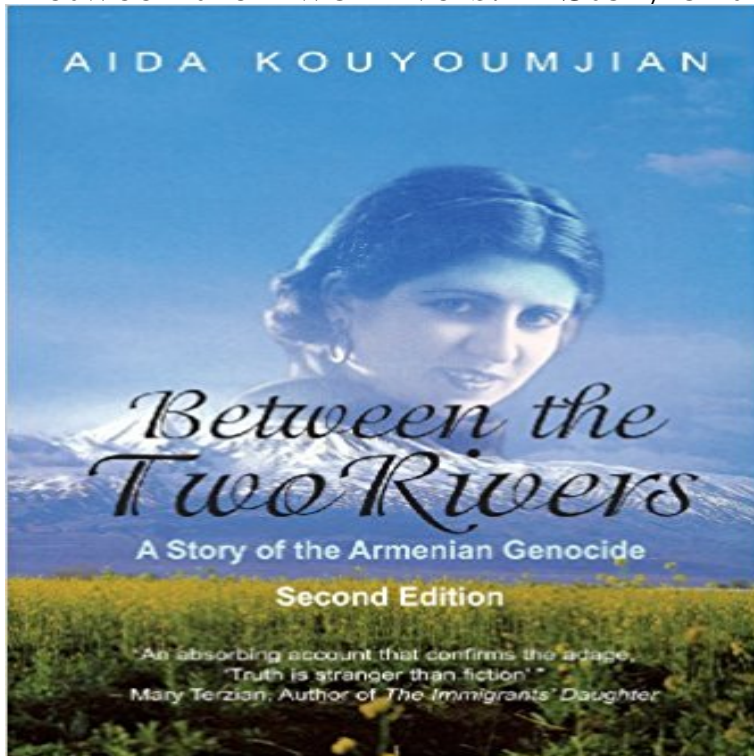


## Between the Two Rivers: A Story of the Armenian Genocide
