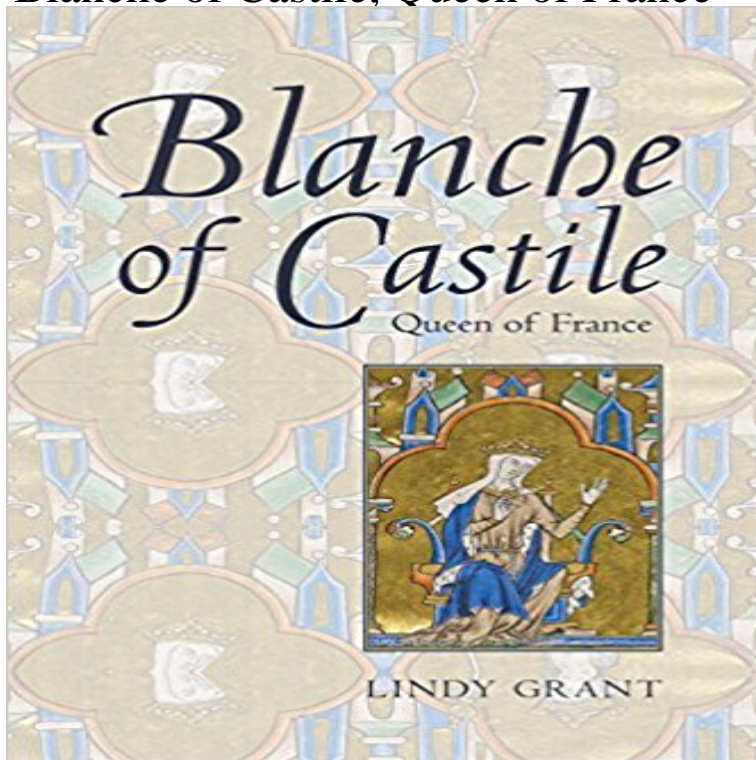


Blanche of Castile, Queen of France
