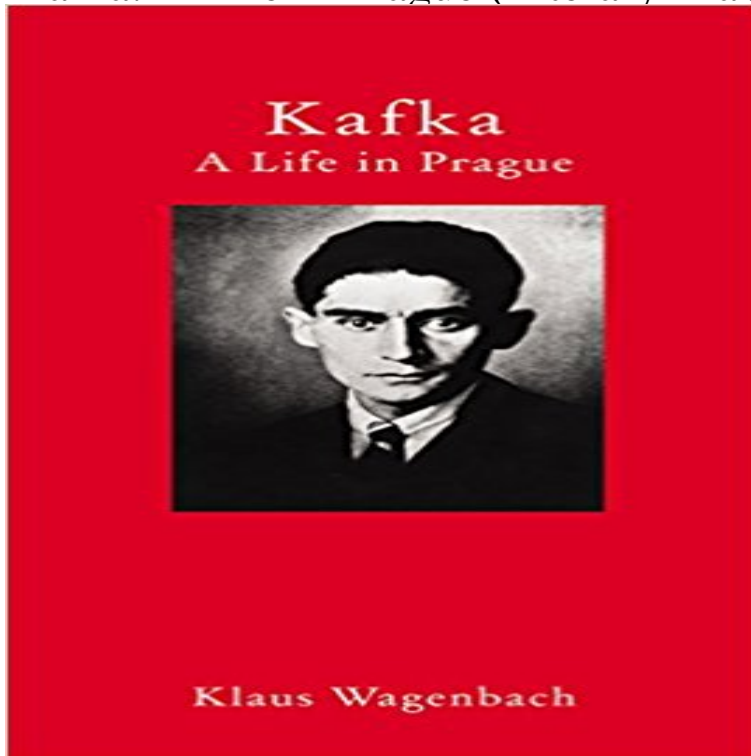


Kafka: A Life in Prague (Literary Travellers)

The result is a fascinating portrait of the 20th centurys most enigmatic writer, in whose works, as W. G. Sebald recognised, literary and life experience overlap.
