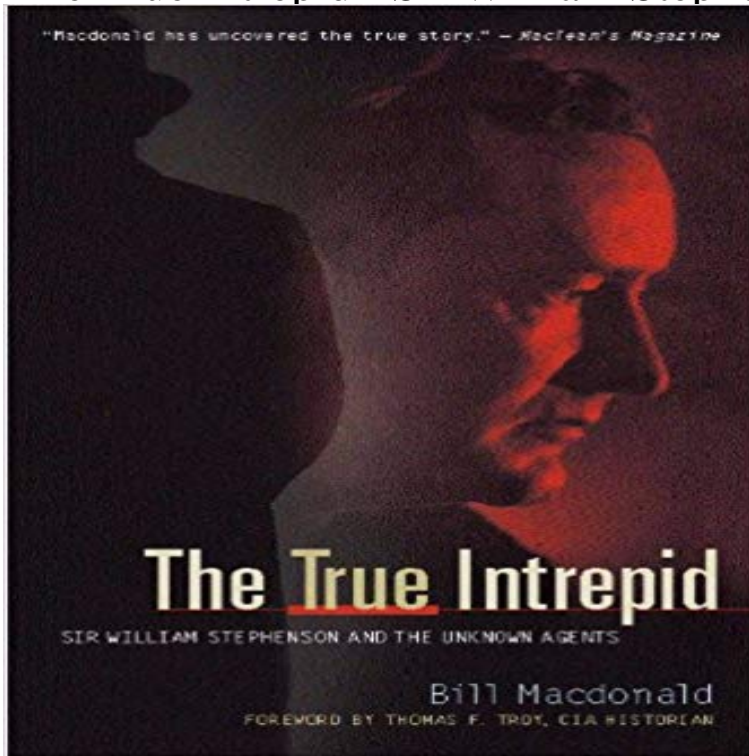


The True Intrepid - Sir William Stephenson and the Unknown Agents



The World War II intelligence exploits of Canadian spymaster William Stephenson were celebrated in his lifetime in espionage lore the world over.
