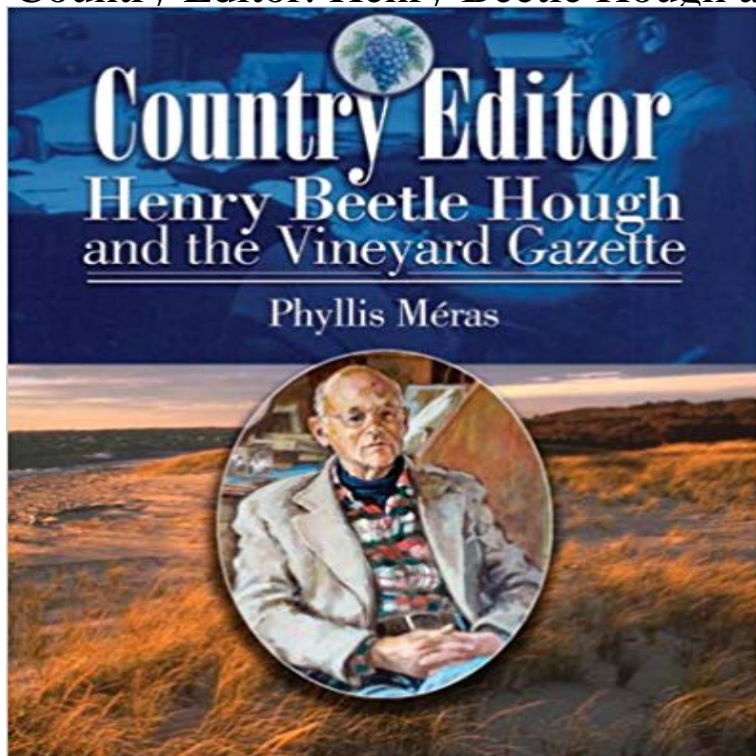


Country Editor: Henry Beetle Hough and the Vineyard Gazette
