
Fichte: The Self and the Calling of Philosophy, 1762-1799

This is the first biography to explain thoroughly how Fichtes philosophy relates to his life experiences as reconstructed from the abundant material in his published and unpublished writings and papers. The approach is primarily historical, but should be of interest to philosophers.
