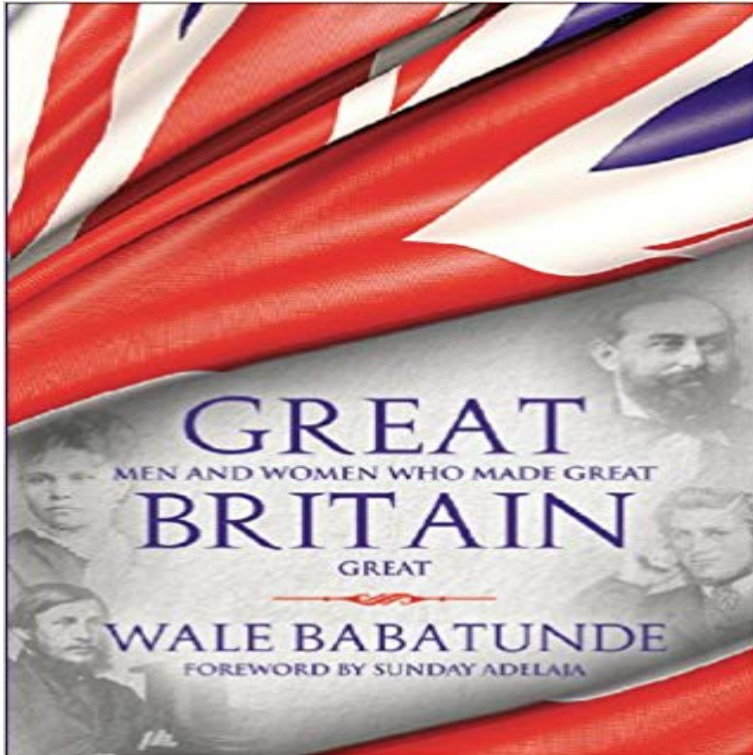


## Great Men and Women who mad Great Britain Great
