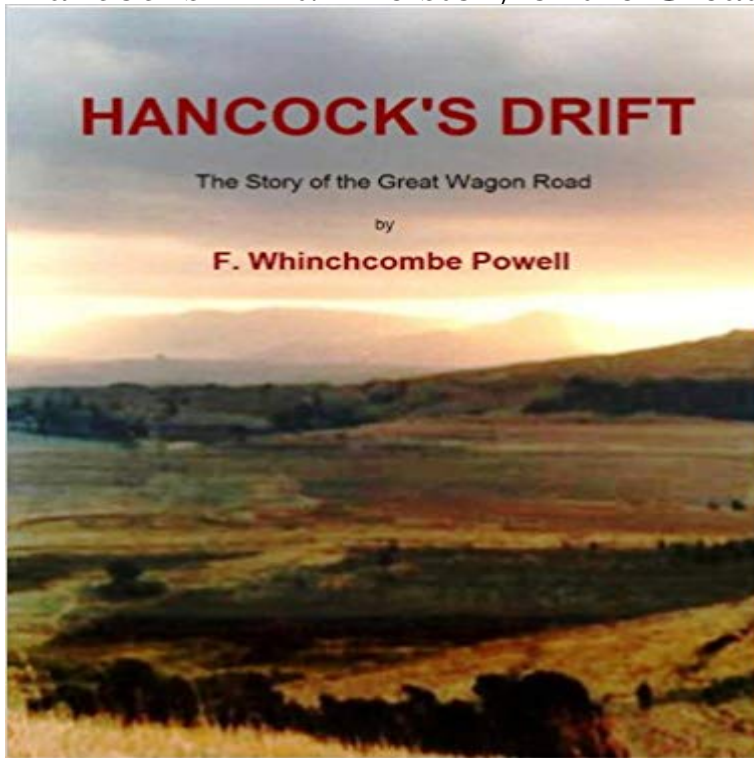


# Hancocks Drift: The story of the Great Wagon Road
