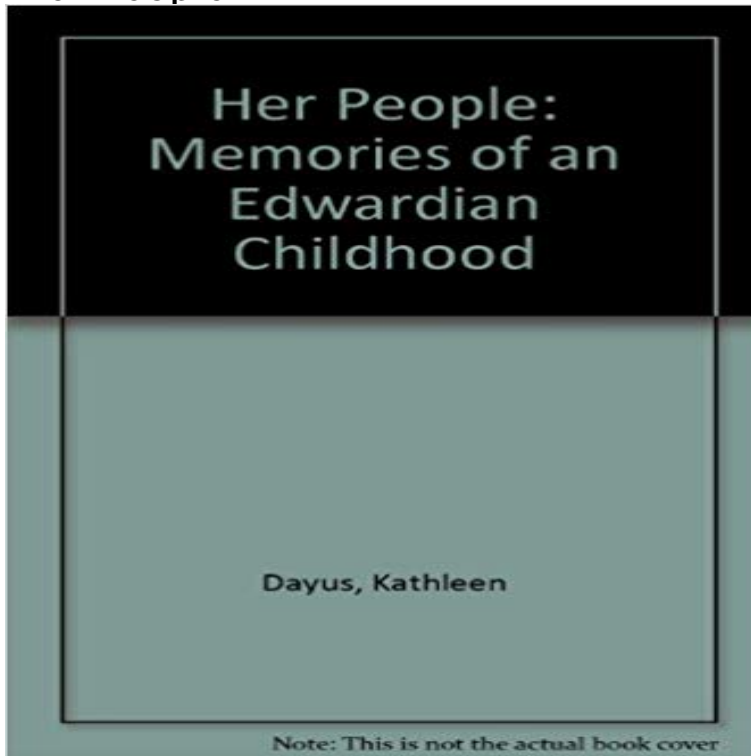


Her People
