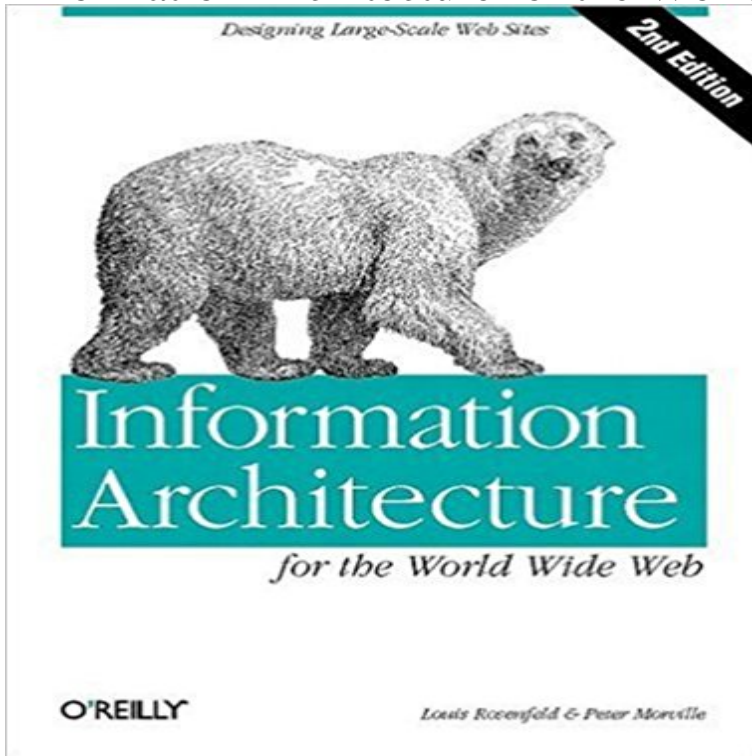


# Information Architecture for the World Wide Web
