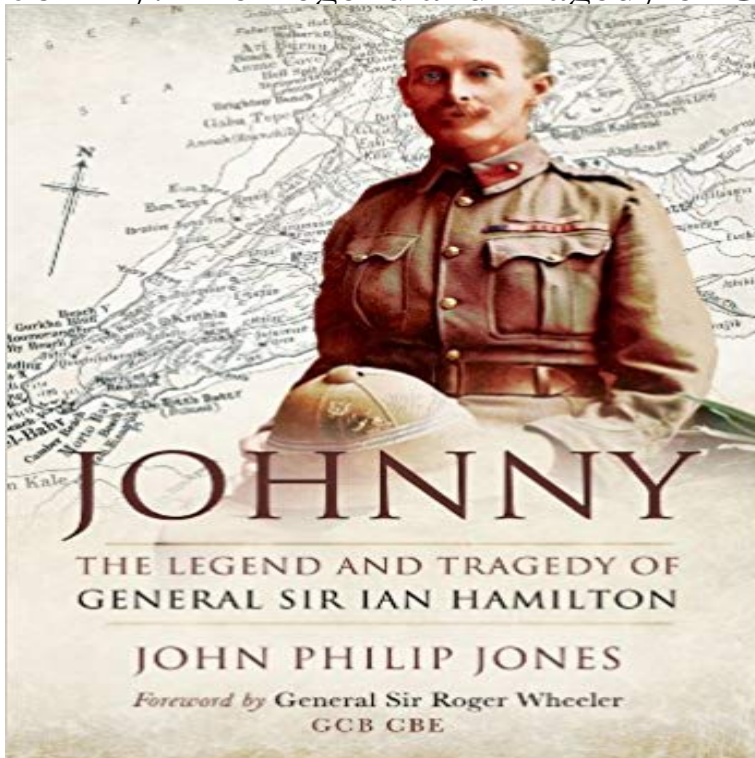


## Johnny: The Legend and Tragedy of General Sir Ian Hamilton
