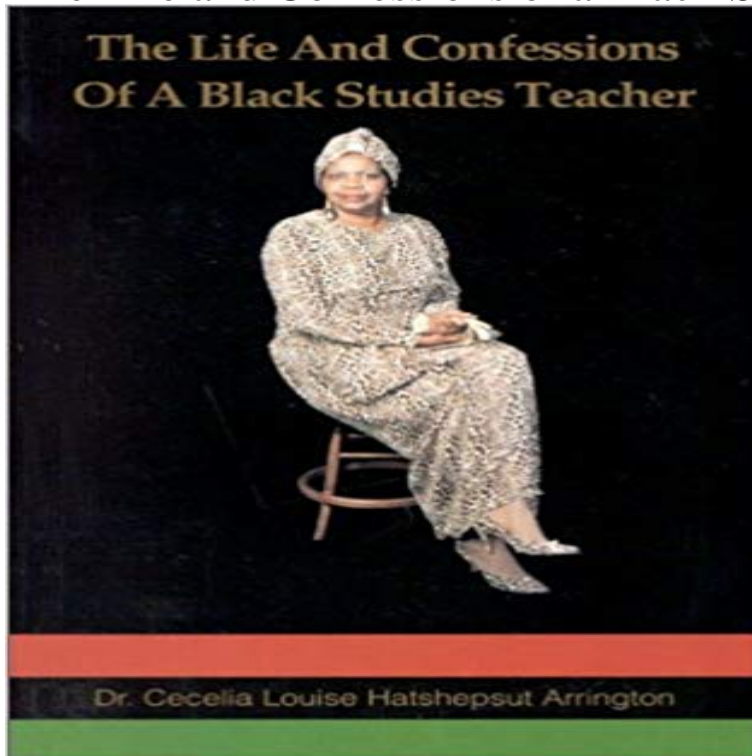


The Life and Confessions of a Black Studies Teacher
