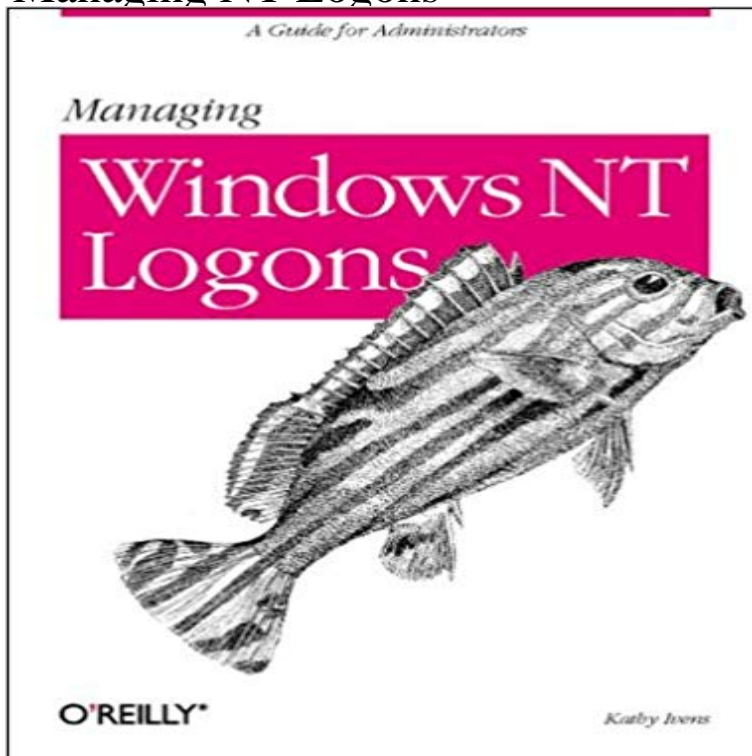


Managing NT Logons



Administrators spend much of their time and energy on workstation problems, those user and logon problems that keep the helpdesk phone jingling. From forgotten passwords to user-caused destruction of workstation environments, the problems are ongoing and unremitting. Some administrators have a real instinct for these kinds of problems; they smell the source and know right away what the solution is. Most of us, however, have to assess the problem logically. This book helps you take that approach. Aimed at administrators who run networks with Windows NT 4.0 Workstation, Windows 95, and Windows 98 clients *Managing Windows NT Logons* puts those common problems and solutions into a volume that administrators can keep at hand and use easily. One of the most frustrating things an administrator can hear is the user complaint my computer wont start, but Chapter 1 talks about the various startup problems you may encounter with your hardware, operating system, or domain server. Startup is only one area where you might encounter a logon emergency.
