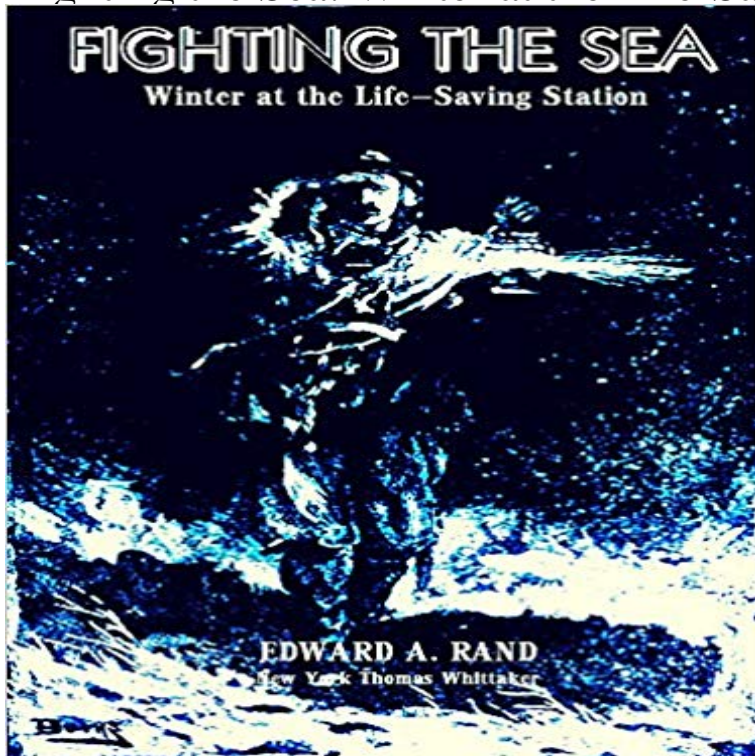


## Fighting the Sea: Winter at the Life-Saving Station
