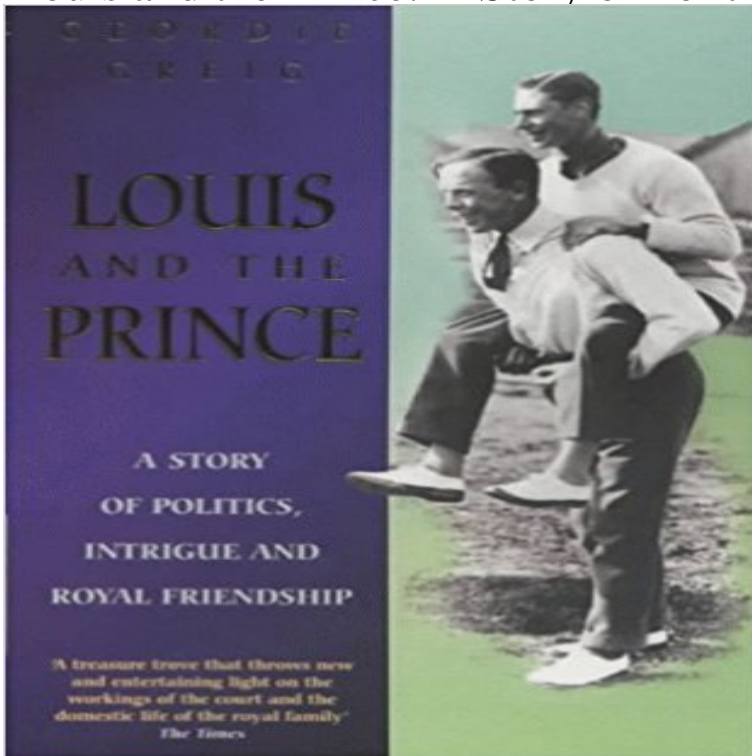


Louis and the Prince: A Story of Politics, Intrigue and Royal Friendship
