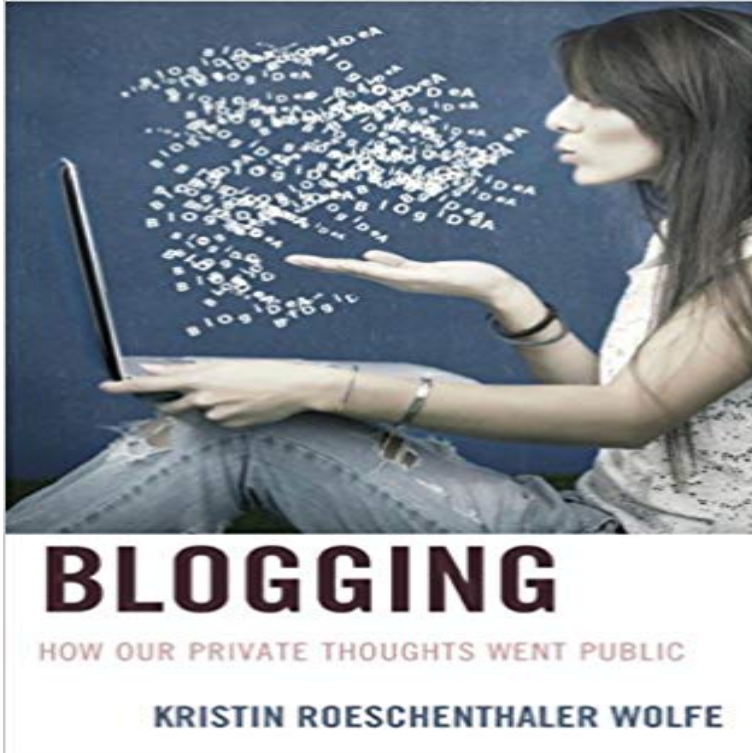


Blogging: How Our Private Thoughts Went Public (Studies in New Media)
