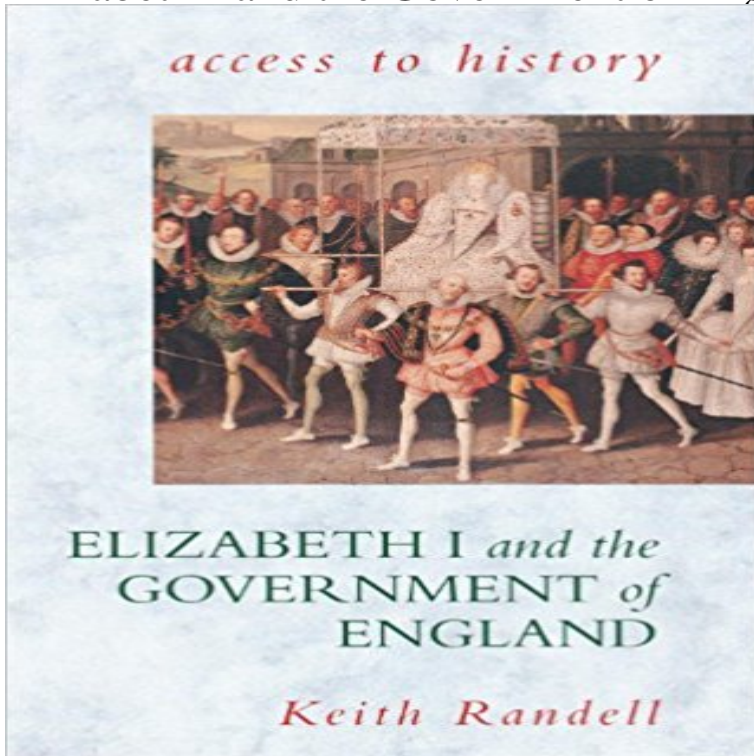


Elizabeth I and the Government of England (Access to History)
