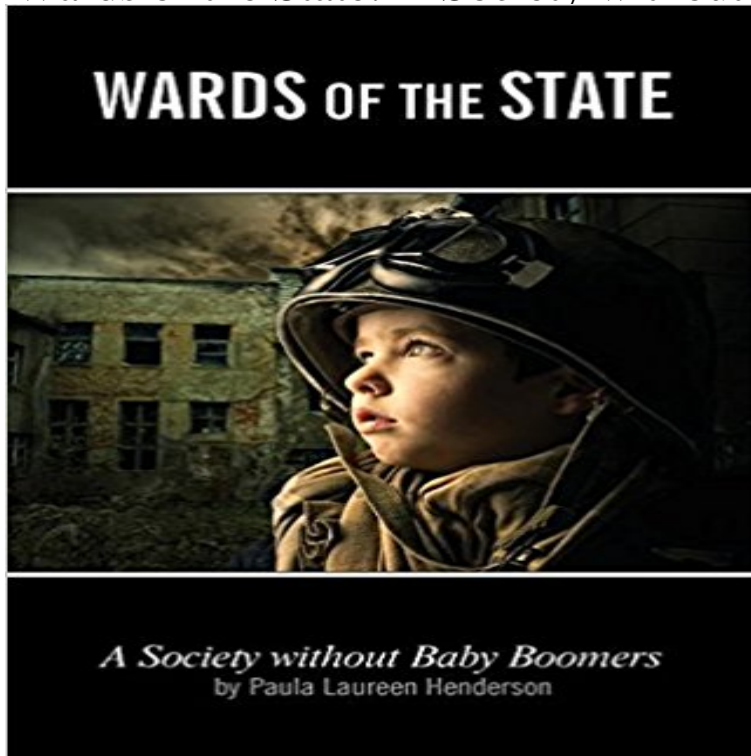


## Wards of the State: A Society without Baby Boomers

Henderson questions the agenda of both national and global political leaders and examines the mindset of the future generation she identifies as the millennial, the daycare generation that holds tightly onto the wait and see what happens mentality. She holds the readers hand as page by page , case study by case study, she gives references to where she has relied on God for strength to renew her hope in finding peace in her life and poses a question to the readers about global peace. She identifies the process of healing. As I was going through treatments for cancer, I was asked, What if you die? to which she replied, I will not die a victim but rather a survivor. Can we even play with the notion of a nation evolving from victim to survivor mentality? Not afraid of confrontation, Hendersons themes are vivid displays of the world today deeply supported with researched factual and scriptural inserts: She identified North Americans as clinging to a dream like in the 1980s, but asks, Isnt it time we wake up?
