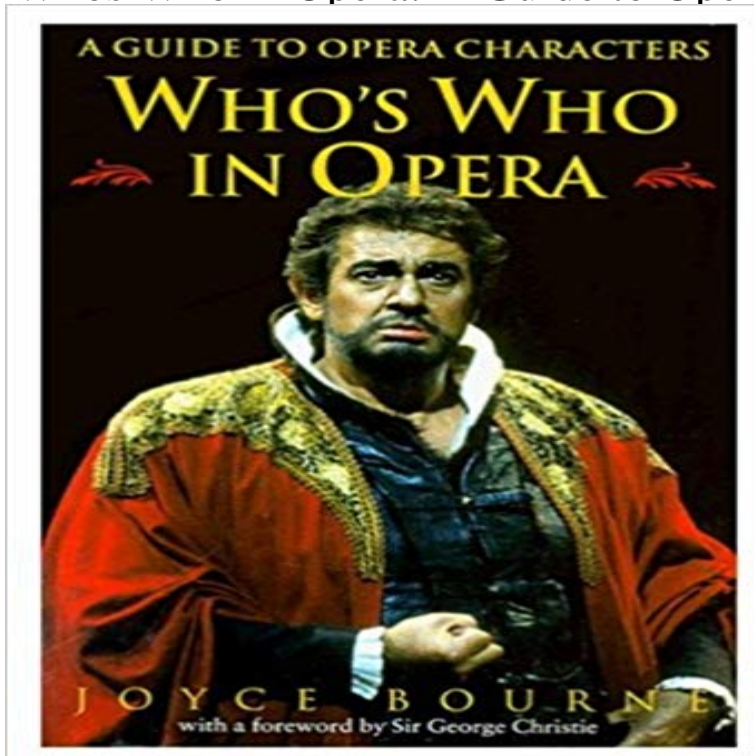


Whos Who in Opera: A Guide to Opera Characters
